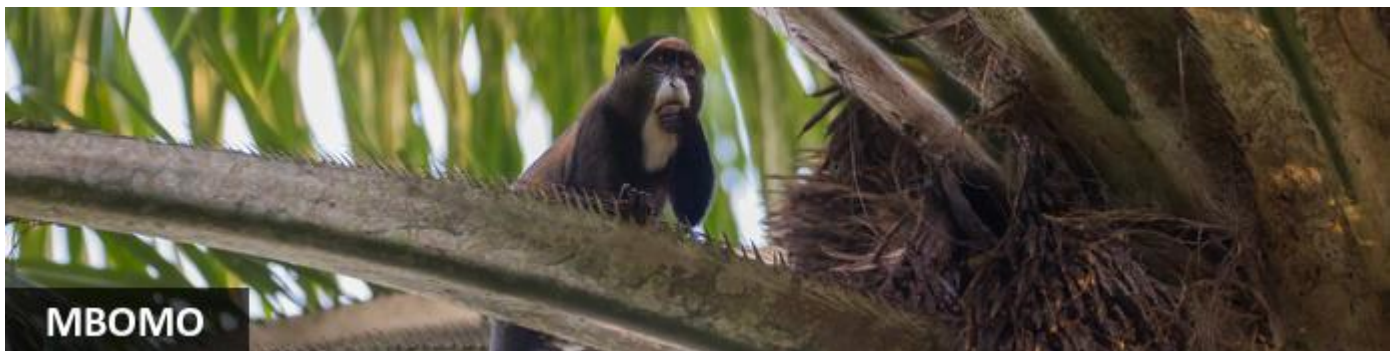

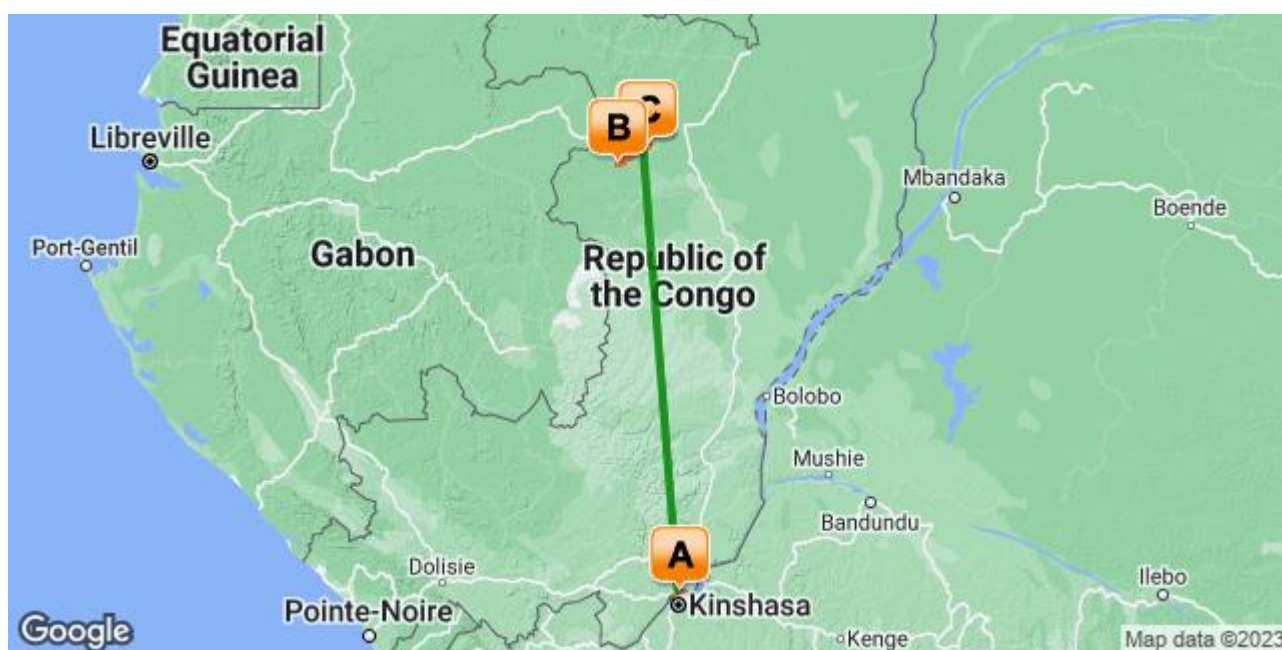

- A yellow fever vaccination will be required

Day 1: Radisson Blu M'bamou Palace Hotel Brazzaville, Brazzaville

On arrival at Maya Maya Airport, you will be met and warmly welcomed to Brazzaville.

You will be transferred in a private vehicle to the Radisson Blu M'bamou Palace Hotel Brazzaville for your overnight stay before heading on safari in the morning.

Depending on your arrival time, a tour of the City can be arranged.

Brazzaville

Set on the banks of the mighty Congo River, overlooking the sprawling metropolis of Kinshasa across the river in the DRC, Brazzaville is a classic central African city and capital of the Republic of Congo. Brazzaville is by far the more appealing of these two neighbouring cities, with a thriving arts scene, great restaurants, vibrant nightlife, a fascinating colonial heritage, and some fabulously friendly locals. Visitors can look forward to relaxing on the city's scenic riverside embankment and exploring several colourful marketplaces, including a lovely candlelit night market. Must-see sights include the insightful national museum, the lush municipal gardens and the house constructed for Joseph Marie de Gaulle when the city served as the capital of Free France. Don't miss the striking Basilica of St Anne, one of the world's most beautiful modern churches.

Overnight: Radisson Blu M'bamou Palace Hotel Brazzaville

Radisson Blu M'bamou Palace Hotel Brazzaville places guests on the banks of the infamous Congo River within Brazzaville's Central Business District. Guests can choose from 178 guest rooms including Presidential Suites and Duplex Apartments. Several on-site dining options present themselves for guests needing a satisfying meal or a nourishing drink from the Spa juice bar. Ideal for family trips as well, the hotel features a children's pool at the Wellness Centre for younger guests while their parents enjoy the sauna or fitness facilities.



Day 2: Ngaga Camp, Mbomo

This morning, you will be collected and transferred back to Maya Maya Airport where you will check in for your Congo Conservation Company's charter flight which departs Brazzaville at 1pm (Monday or Thursday only) and arrives Odzala at 3pm (2 hours).

On arrival at Mboko Airstrip, you will be met and transferred by road to Ngaga Camp. The transfer is approximately 3 hours of driving through the Odzala-Kokoua National Park.

On arrival at Ngaga Camp, you will check in and freshen up and then meet the gorilla research team before enjoying dinner.

Mbomo

Situated in the heart of the second largest tropical rainforest in the world in the west of the Democratic Republic of Congo, Mbomo is a village serves as the capital of the Mbombo District in the Cuvette-Ouest Region. The village provides an excellent base from which to explore the spectacularly scenic surrounding landscape boasting thick canopies, unique flora and extraordinary wildlife. This area is known as a paradise for nature-lovers featuring over 400 species of bird, 20 000 western lowland gorillas and the rare forest elephant.

Overnight: Ngaga Camp

Originally founded as a centre for primate research and a pilot gorilla tourism project, Ngaga Camp was the first camp to receive support from the Congo Conservation Company joining communities, science and tourism on the grounds of conservation. Located outside the park boundary in the Ndzehe concession, overlooking a canopy of primary forest above a forest stream, Ngaga Camp is situated within the overlapping home ranges of several groups of western lowland gorillas, three of which are habituated.

A focal point for world-class research as well as unforgettable primate encounters, Ngaga Camp's unique design evokes the fun and mystery of childhood treehouses. From the six elevated guest rooms, wraparound walkways allow you to peer directly into the forest canopy. Each chalet has an en-suite bathroom with hot shower and flush toilet, mosquito net, fans and South African power points with European and UK adapters, and environmentally friendly soaps and shampoos.



Day 3: Ngaga Camp, Mbomo

This morning you will go Gorilla tracking with a guide and tracker from our team, before returning to Ngaga Camp for lunch.

Relax after lunch and then head out on a forest walk where you'll marvel at the bird and forest life, ending with a river sundowners.



Day 4: Ngaga Camp, Mbomo

Another Gorilla tracking experience this morning with a guide and tracker from our team, followed by lunch at Ngaga Camp.

This afternoon you'll spend time with the gorilla research team, before departing on another forest walk and a night walk to view nocturnal forest life.

Day 5: Lango Camp, Odzala Kokoua National Park

After a leisurely breakfast, you'll be transferred by road through the Mbomo village and the Odzala-Kokoua National Park to Mboko Camp, arriving in time for lunch.

After lunch, a kayak experience on the Lekoli River will take you across to Lango Camp, where you can relax for the afternoon a venture on a discovery baï walk, followed by sundowners.

Odzala Kokoua National Park

Located in the heart of Africa, in the Cuvette-Ouest region of the Republic of Congo, the Odzala Kokoua National Park is renowned for its spectacular lowland gorillas. The park is comprised of the vast Congo Basin which contains the second-largest unspoilt biodiverse tropical rainforest in the world, which creates the ideal environment for these majestic creatures to thrive in. Visitors come to this park for an experience of a lifetime- catching a glimpse of the western lowland gorilla in the wild. Jump on a safari adventure and discover the stretches of open savannah, remote pristine rainforest, crystal clear streams, and a variety of unique birds and other wildlife.

Overnight: Lango Camp

Today, Odzala Discovery Camps - Ngaga Camp, Lango Camp and Mboko Camp - are gaining fast traction with travellers who visit to experience the western lowland gorillas, forest elephant, bongo and many more species through a 4, 7 or 10 night itinerary between the 3 camps.

Lango Baï is home to Lango Camp in the natural, swampy clearing in the forest with large deposits of minerals - a magnetic attraction for huge flocks of African green pigeons and African grey parrots, as well as for herds of forest buffalo by day and forest elephants by night. The six guest chalets have been strategically placed on the edge of Lango Baï with views out onto the open baï, one of the most arresting views of any camp in Africa.

Remote areas in Africa are under threat and need to be commercially viable in order to be protected. This is vision of Congo Conservation Company - to take an innovative approach to pioneering eco-tourism in the Congo Basin. The aim of CCC is to be a conservation actor by providing added value to the Odzala-Kokoua National Park and Dzanga-Sangha Special Reserve through the development of tourism, and every visit counts.



Day 6: Lango Camp, Odzala Kokoua National Park

Wake up early this morning for a walk through the baï to get your feet wet.

You will return to Lango Camp for lunch.

Afternoon relaxation, followed by a forest walk and then some bird watching from the camp deck.



Day 7: Mboko Camp, Odzala Kokoua National Park

This morning you will head out on a guided walk, with breakfast overlooking the baï. You'll walk along a wooden path, through the swamp and then on a game drive vehicle to Mboko Camp for lunch.

This afternoon, experience a river cruise on the Lekoli River, swimming in the Likeni River or a guided forest walk.

Overnight: Mboko Camp

Today, Odzala Discovery Camps - Ngaga Camp, Lango Camp and Mboko Camp - are gaining fast traction with travellers who visit to experience the western lowland gorillas, forest elephant, bongo and many more species through a 4, 7 or 10 night itinerary between the 3 camps.

The combination of wide-open grasslands dotted with architectural termite mounds, gently flowing rivers and towering forests result in a kind of magical calm. The peace of this location washes over you, leaving you open to receive what the forest wants to share with you. With a variety of habitats to explore on foot, by vehicle and by boat, each day holds a new adventure.

Located inside Odzala-Kokoua National Park and the closest of the camps to the private airstrip. Mboko Camp features ten guest chalets (double-occupancy and 2 family), each set within along the Lekoli River amidst the lush green forest-line of the savannah creating privacy. Each room has an en-suite bathroom with hot shower and flush toilet, mosquito net, environmentally friendly soaps and shampoos. Embrace the tranquillity of the river babbling past and the freedom of open plains as thunder storms dance along the horizon.



Day 8: Mboko Camp, Odzala Kokoua National Park

After breakfast, head out on a guided walk through the forest, or simply take some time to relax and enjoy the savannah views and see what you can spot!

Enjoy lunch at Mboko Camp.

This afternoon you can choose to enjoy a relaxing river cruise on the Lekoli River, swimming in the Likeni River or a guided forest walk.

Day 9: End of Itinerary

After breakfast at Mboko Camp, you will say a sad goodbye to the wonderful camp staff and depart on the Congo Conservation Company's scheduled flight which departs Odzala at 9am, and arrives at Brazzaville at 11am, landing at Maya Maya Airport.

Here you will connect with your onward flight home or spend an additional night in Brazzaville soaking up the city atmosphere. Guided excursions can be arranged at an additional cost.
