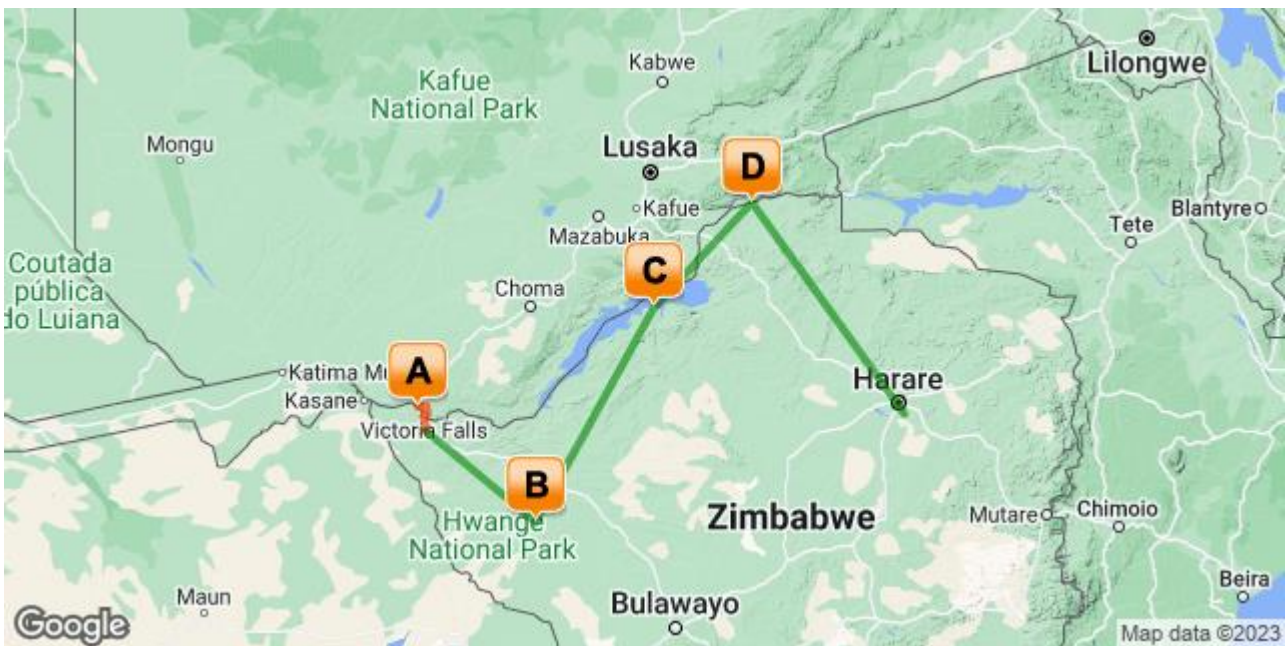

Day 1-3: African Bush Camps Thorntree River Lodge, Victoria Falls (Zambia)

On arrival at Livingstone International Airport, you will be met and warmly welcomed to Zambia.

You will be transferred in a private vehicle to Thorntree River Lodge for your 2-night stay.

Just twenty minutes upstream from Victoria Falls, this beautifully designed lodge is set on the banks of the Zambezi River in the Mosi-Oa-Tunya National Park. Thorntree River Lodge offers the perfect base to experience the plethora of activities in and around the Lodge, from witnessing the majestic Victoria Falls to cruising or canoeing on the river, to game drives and rhino tracking to bungee jumping and helicopter flights and Spa treatments at the Lodge. Children of all ages are most welcome and the Ngwana kids Club will ensure hours of fun for your kids of all ages.

Activities included in your package: Game drives in Mosi-oa-Tunya National Park, rhino tracking, bush walks, sunrise & sunset boat cruises, Simonga Village visits, a visit to Zambian side of the Falls, a visit to the Zimbabwean side of the Falls in low water season (excludes visa fees), visit to the Livingstone Museum, canoe trips, visit to Maramba & Makuni Markets, catch & release fishing (not available in December due to breeding season).

Overnight: African Bush Camps Thorntree River Lodge

Thorntree River Lodge is set in Zambia's Mosi-Oa-Tunya National Park, just a short distance from the famous Victoria Falls. Thorntree River Lodge has been completely rebuilt with an environmentally-conscious design. Drawing inspiration from local customs and culture, it is a modern contemporary design with tented roof structures to maintain the feel of authentic Africa.



Day 3-6: African Bush Camps Somalisa Camp, Southern Hwange National Park

Today you will be transferred across the border into Zimbabwe, where you will fly with fellow passengers on a light aircraft to Hwange National Park.

The flight will take approximately 45 minutes.

On arrival at Manga Airstrip, you will be met and game-driven the 30-minutes to the Lodge.

This family-friendly safari lodge is located on the edge of a seasonal floodplain, tucked beneath the dappled shade of an Acacia grove. Hwange is the largest reserve in Zimbabwe, and famous for its rich diversity of wildlife. Children of all ages are welcomed and the 2 family tents have inter-leading walkways between the parents and children's rooms which are both en-suite and have a private deck offering panoramic 180-degree views of the surrounding bush.

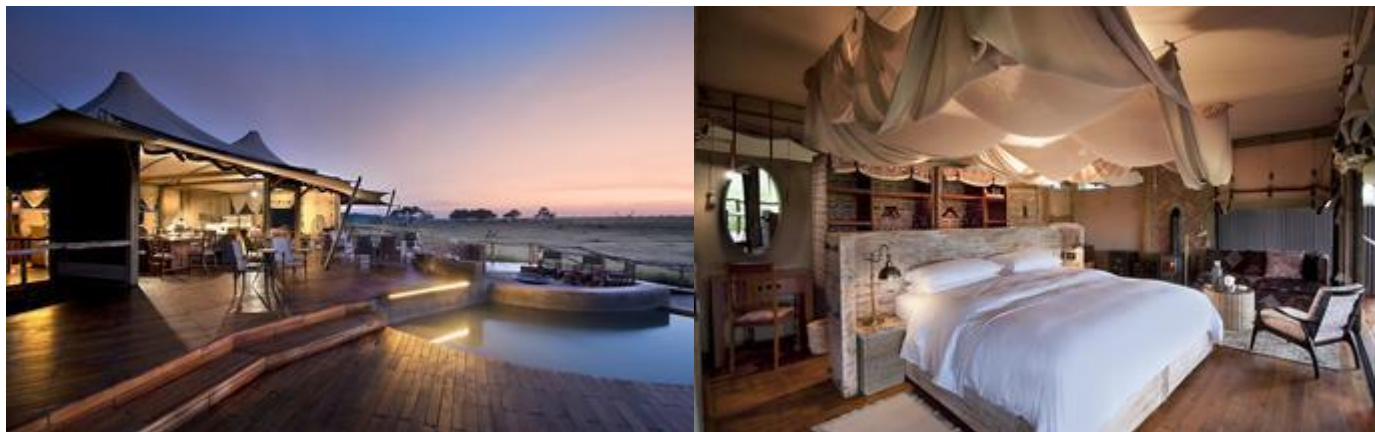
Activities included in your package: morning & afternoon game drives, walking safaris, Hwange Main Camp village visits, Mambanje Village visit (private vehicle required at associated costs for Mambanje Village Visit). Walking safaris are restricted to children aged 16 years and older.

Southern Hwange National Park

Located in western Zimbabwe, Hwange National Park (formerly Wankie Game Reserve) is the largest natural reserve in the country and is famous for its rich diversity of wildlife. Home to one of the biggest elephant populations in the world, as well as around 100 mammal species, the park is popular among animal lovers. Several protected species inhabit the awe-inspiring open landscapes, including the endangered wild dog, critically endangered black rhino, and rare roan and sable - along with lion, cheetah, and around 500 bird species. Adventurers can look forward to guided bush hikes, game drives, and horse riding safaris, all of which offer excellent photographic opportunities.

Overnight: African Bush Camps Somalisa Camp

Hwange National Park is a land of contrasts from dense teak and acacia forest to vast open savannah, offering guests an exhibition of raw and diverse Africa. This intimate bush camp is perfect for a relaxing Hwange safari with friends and loved ones. Somalisa Camp is a place where tranquillity meets adventure. Where one moment you are sipping on your gin and tonic, listening to the distant baritone roar of a lion coalition off on the hunt, and the next you are gazing over at a congregation of elephants at your doorstep, peacefully sharing a sundowner with you. Every person is part of the community that helps create the magical and welcoming feeling you get when you visit Somalisa, you arrive as a guest, but you leave a part of the family.



Day 6-8: African Bush Camps Bumi Hills Safari Lodge, Lake Kariba

After breakfast, you will be collected and transferred back to the airstrip where you and fellow passengers will fly to Bumi Hills Safari Lodge.

The flight is approximately 1 hour 30 minutes.

On arrival at the Bumi Hills airstrip, you will be met and transferred to the Lodge.

Bumi Hills is set with the Zambezi escarpment as its backdrop and overlooking Lake Kariba. This private concession allows for wildlife to roam freely from the Matusadona national park, offering exciting game-viewing activities, as well as the water-based activities on Lake Kariba.

Activities included in your package: morning, afternoon & night game drives, walking safaris, boating, catch-and-release fishing, cultural village visits to the nearby community and sunset cruises. Walking safaris are restricted to children aged 16 years and older.

Should you prefer a more private lodging, the Baobab Villa is a 2-bedroomed private villa, complete with its own living room bar and indoor and outdoor dining decks, and includes the services of a private butler, safari guide and a dedicated safari vehicle.

Overnight: African Bush Camps Bumi Hills Safari Lodge

Bumi Hills Safari Lodge boasts one of Africa's finest wilderness locations with an elevated position on a range of remote hills overlooking the vastness of Lake Kariba. Bumi is situated near the North Eastern border of the Matusadona National Park and is easily accessible by light aircraft and boat, allowing you to be swiftly transported into paradise without the stress of a long journey.

The safari lodge has a total of 10 luxury rooms, all with balconies and uninhibited views over Lake Kariba. Taking centre stage is the beautiful infinity pool that seems to blend endlessly into the lake horizon. The pool is surrounded by intimate wine and dining terraces on different levels. The lodge interiors have been beautifully finished in a fusion of contemporary western and African styles.

Not only is Kariba's shoreline rich in wildlife but the lodge's proximity to Matusadona allows for the animals roam freely between the national park and Bumi Hills' private concession. Activities include guided walking safaris, stargazing, boating, birding, catch-and-release fishing, day and night game drives searching for lions in particular, as well as engaging cultural visits to our nearby local community.



Day 8-11: African Bush Camps Nyamatusi Mahogany, Mana Pools National Park

After breakfast, you will be collected and transferred back to the airstrip where you and fellow passengers will fly to Nyamatusi Mahogany in Mana Pools.

The flight is approximately 30 minutes.

On arrival at the Mana Main airstrip, you will be met and experience a 45-minute game drive to the Lodge.

Open from 1 April - 5 January, Nyamatusi Mahogany offers the perfect luxury safari experience for families, set beneath ancient mahogany trees on the lush shores of the mighty Zambezi River. Promoting a philosophy that embraces families in the wild, Nyamatusi Mahogany offers a diverse range of enthralling activities for children of all ages.

Activities included in your package: morning, afternoon game drives, walking safaris, catch-and-release shore fishing, and canoeing. Walking and canoeing is restricted to children 16 years and older.

Overnight: African Bush Camps Nyamatusi Mahogany

Nyamatusi Mahogany is the perfect luxury safari experience for families. Consisting of 2 luxury tented suites and 2 luxury family suites nested under ancient mahogany trees on the lush shores of the mighty Zambezi River, the camp has been designed with style and serenity in mind.

Mana Pools, known as one of the last pioneer parks lying in the great African Rift valley, is an explorers' paradise. Here, guests are able to experience the raw power of nature when canoeing down the Zambezi River, or watch a wildlife extravaganza unfold on game drives.
